

EDUC 0396: SEMINAR IN COMPUTERS IN EDUCATION

Courses both practical and theoretical issues related to the use of technology in education.

MATERIALS: There is no required text and all course content will be available online. However you will need to have access to Microsoft Word for assignments.

COURSE OVERVIEW: This course will deliver the three course components of the National Educational Technology Standards, the skills and the assignments that will assist you in implementing them in your classroom.

Most of this coursework will be done in an online environment. This week you will take an online tour of the course website and receive directions on how to use the management system. The rest of the course will be entirely online through threaded discussions and email. Lecture notes, reading assignments, and all assignments will be handed in online. There is no text book to purchase. If you have experience with online coursework, I'd like to provide you with a few tips for a successful one.

The virtual classroom, as this online class is called, has much in common with a traditional classroom. You will still have lectures, discussions, projects, papers and assessments. The main difference is that you now have the ability to complete your course work from anywhere on the Internet. This gives you increased flexibility but also requires self-discipline on your part.
